

Report on the Installation of Office Bearers and Executive Committee Members for 2026–27. Installation Ceremony Held at Quilon Beach Hotel, Kollam

The installation ceremony of the office bearers and Executive Committee members for the year 2026–27 was held on 10 August 2026 at Quilon Beach Hotel, Kollam.
